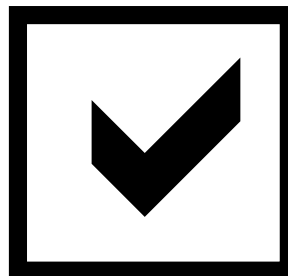


# Stay Safe During the 2010 Census

Census information is used to determine the needs of each state and community for federal funding, among other things.

A Census worker will not ask:

- ✓ Social Security Numbers
- ✓ Bank Account Numbers
- ✓ Credit Card Numbers
- ✓ Will Not Contact You by Email



Census workers may inquire about your salary range, However, you do not have to answer any questions about your financial situation.

Do not share information with individuals without Census credentials (an identification badge and a Census canvas bag that is black with white lettering.) Ask to see their identification before answering their questions. However, you should never invite anyone you don't know into your home. Younger family members should not open the doors to anyone without an adult in the household.

At this time Census workers are knocking on doors to verify address information only. In coming months you may be contacted by the US Census by phone, mail or in person. Do not open email stating it is from the Census. If you have questions about the census in Wyoming please call the Cheyenne Census Office at 307-459-1760.

Support the Census but stay safe by exercising caution when sharing information.
